Health Clinics

Our health clinics contain specialized equipment staffed by experienced medical practitioners who offer free specialized healthcare to children. We also have urgent care clinics for orphaned children to receive emergency medical attention when needed.

In addition to these clinics, our medical centers also comprise of a pharmacy, a laboratory, and an X-ray room.

Surgical Procedures

To date over 116,000 orphaned children have been treated in Iraq, and over 2,600 surgeries have been successfully completed. Al-Ayn collaborates with hospitals and medical professionals domestically and internationally for medical cases needing additional attention. Al-Ayn also facilitates surgical operations for orphaned children in Afghanistan and Ghana.

Child's Name:

Ridha

Required Treatment:

Liver transplant

Age at Diagnosis:

3 days old

Treatment Details:

After receiving treatment for his condition in Karbala, Al-Ayn's medical specialists determined that Ridha required a liver transplant outside of Iraq. Al-Ayn arranged for Ridha to travel to India, and his mother served as the donor. Al-Ayn covered the costs of the transplant which was successfully conducted by the end of 2022. Al-Ayn also ensured that Ridha underwent additional examinations and a health assessment in India, including further surgery and the administration of prescribed medication. Ridha is now in a stable and good condition.

Required Treatment:

Renal transplant

Age at Diagnosis:

1 day old

Treatment Details:

Ali was diagnosed with renal failure at birth and, with the support of Al-Ayn, was receiving regular kidney dialysis. Al-Ayn later covered the costs for Ali to be relocated to Sulaymaniyah for a kidney transplant, with his mother serving as the donor. The transplant was successful, and he is currently in good health.

Required Treatment:

Quadruple Bypass

Age at Diagnosis:

1 day old

Treatment Details:

Muhammad underwent a quadruple bypass surgery for his heart. Unfortunately, the surgery was unsuccessful, leading to a deterioration in his condition. Al-Ayn arranged for Muhammed to be treated by a cardiac specialist. A challenging and intricate corrective procedure was carried out, ultimately achieving success. Following the surgery, Muhammed experienced a significant improvement in his health.

Orphaned children require secure and nurturing homes that offer warmth, safety, and stability, fostering their ability to experience a fulfilling childhood. Many of the orphaned families that come to Al-Ayn are living in houses with no adequate space and no protection from harsh weather. Some houses have broken windows or doors, or are damaged in ways that make it dangerous for children to play in.

Al-Ayn has established multifaceted housing complexes in Iraq to ensure orphaned children and their families receive new homes. Every home provided is fully equipped. Additionally, our housing project also focuses on renovating existing homes, ensuring they are suitable and safe for orphaned children to reside in.

We used to live in a really old house. Whenever it rained, our house would get flooded with rainwater and creepy insects. But this new house has good and clean walls. I even have my own room now and can read my books in peace!



For eleven-year-old Saif, gaining a new home is likely a very defining moment in his childhood. He no longer needs to worry about the weather having such a destructive impact on his day. He may even start enjoying the sound of the raindrops on his window from the comfort of his new room.
